Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Taking turns through games and sharing resources.

Looking after each other and recognising other's feelings.

Mindful monster sessions

Develop resilience and perseverance in the face of challenges

Communication and Language

Answer how and why questions

Concentrate and listen attentively in different situations

Listen and respond to stories, discussions and songs

Extend vocabulary using weekly word aware strategies

Develop their own stories and narratives through story scribing

Use large equipment to develop gross motor skills and stamina

Develop good pencil grip through good finger strength

Begin to form letters and numbers correctly

Real PE- cognitive unit, focussing on dynamic and static balance.

Counting-1-1 corr beyond 10:
Recognising numerals to 20: Subitising to 6

Comparison- knowing the number that is one more or one less. Knowing the difference between amounts

Composition- how numbers to 10 and beyond can be made. Finding the missing amount to make a whole

Recap and consolidate phase 2 phonemes and graphemes

Repeat phase 3 sounds

Learn phase 2 and 3 tricky words

Segment and blend the sounds in simple words

Begin to read simple words in books independently

Writing

Use writing as an integral part of play inside and outside, using lots of resources

Writing some correct sounds, some simple words, or the beginnings of sentences independently

Writing labels, captions and messages in response to play and drawing club

Drawing Club- shared writing, including labels and captions

Understanding the World

Noticing and talking about their environment and how it differs to others

Noticing and describing changes in their environment

Observation station - observing flowers growing, noticing differences and similarities

RE: Jesus resurrection and new life.

Expressive Arts and Design

Drawing Club- response to stories and songs

Collage-Use a variety of natural and manmade materials to make a free collage. Tear or cut paper to represent something. Look at the works of Matisse.
