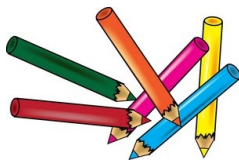

Dropping Off & Collecting Your Child

All the KS1 children should start arriving by **8:40am** in preparation for school starting at **8:45am**. Children should line up in their classes.

Children will be brought down on to the playground for collection at **3:15pm**. Please inform the office if your child is being collected by anyone different.

Please could we ask that all children are kept off the tyres at the end of the day.

Water Bottles & Equipment

Please make sure your child has a named water bottle in school with them every day.

Your child only needs to bring their book bag to school for their reading books and letters. Please do not bring anything additional as school can provide equipment.

Please do not send your child in with toys or any other personal items that could get lost or damaged at school

Reading Practice & Spellings

We teach phonics and reading through Bug Club phonics. Our reading books match this scheme and the resources are used in lessons throughout KS1. We **do not** have a weekly spelling test and children will not be receiving weekly spellings. You will be given tricky words to look at and practice with your child at home and these will be focused on in class that week.

PE Days

Jeffers—Wednesdays (indoor) and Friday (outdoor)

Kerr —Tuesdays (indoor) and Wednesdays (outdoor)

Biddulph —Tuesdays (outdoor) and Wednesdays (indoor)

P.E. Kit

Children should **come to school wearing their PE kits on their class PE days**. They must be dressed in accordance with school guidance as laid out on the school website.

They need to wear:

- Plain white/pale blue t-shirt
- Blue or black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Sports trainers—mainly black/white
- Tracksuit top (for outdoor PE)
- No jewellery
- Long hair tied back

On days when your child has a club after school, they need to bring their P.E. kit in and get changed at the end of the day.
