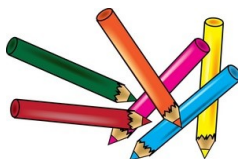

### **Dropping Off & Collecting Your Child**

The school day starts at 8:45am

Your child will need to head to the upper playground and be ready to line up after the bell is rung at 8.45am

A member of the KS2 team will be on the upper playground from 8.40am

The school day ends at 3.15pm.

Your child can be collected from the upper playground.

### **Water Bottles & Equipment**

Please make sure your child has a named water bottle in school with them every day.

Your child only needs to bring their bag to school for their reading books, letters and a packed lunch. Please don't send your child into school with large, distracting pencil cases.

### **Homework**

We would really appreciate your support at home with;

- Hearing your child read at least 3 times a week, reading to them and discussing the story.
- Working on learning multiplication tables.
- Helping your child with their weekly spellings .

### **PE Days**

Our PE day is Wednesday. Please can your child attend school in their PE kit on this day.

Year 4 will also take part in Swimming lessons as part of the national curriculum for PE. When it is your child's turn to swim you will receive a letter in advance with all the details.

If your child is attending an after school PE club, they will come to school in their school uniform as usual and change after school for their activity.

### **P.E. Kit**

Children should **come to school wearing their PE kits on their class PE days**. They must be dressed in accordance with school guidance as laid out on our website.

They need to wear:

- Plain white/pale blue t-shirt,
- Blue or black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Sports trainers– mainly black/white.
- Blue or black Tracksuit top (in colder weather)
- No Jewellery
- Long hair tied back
