

# What's been happening in Owls and Foxes classes...

We read the book **Colour Monster**, which explores feelings and emotions. We talked about how we feel and what colours that reminded us of. We made pictures of the colour monsters and even thought of our own. As we enjoyed the theme of monsters we carried this on and we loved hearing the story **We're Going on a Monster Hunt**, which reminded us of We're going on a Bear hunt. We then made up our hunts and made maps of where we would go searching. The children's imagination has been sparked and the staff have been impressed by their drawings, creations and ideas.



We have begun Phase 2 phonics now, which helps children recognise letters, know the sounds they make and write them correctly. We also play games to support early reading, which include blending some sounds together to make simple words. We have looked at s and a, and next week we will look at the letters t, p, i, n. Next week we will send you a link to allow your child to play the online games at home too, using the Phonics Bug scheme we use at school. ## Wellies

As usual please name ALL PE clothes, as staff and children find it difficult to know which hoody belongs to which child!
