

What's been happening in Owls and Foxes classes...

After reading Room on the Broom last week, the children became very interested in the dragon! We continued this theme this week, using the story 'There's a dragon in your book' to inspire our play and writing. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7YE-qqzWyTU

We thought of ideas about how to help the baby dragon fly and imagined it flying all the way to space! This led to an interest in space, which we will explore more next week. We will find out more about the planets and stars and how we can travel into space. I wonder if we will find aliens!





We are continuing Phase 2 phonics and we have now looked at s, a ,t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, e, r, u. We will now start to learn the 'tricky words', which are those words which we cannot sound out or blend. We just have to remember them! In maths we have been learning lots of ways to make 5 and have been really good at spotting what is missing and what we need to add to an amount to make 5.



IN RE we are beginning to learn about advent and Jesus' birth. We will explore the meaning behind 'birthday' and what it means in preparation for celebrating the birth of Jesus. Next week we will learn about the message that the angel gave Mary and why it was such good news.
