In maths we have been sharing objects into 2 or 3 groups. We have learnt to use the words fair, equal, share and explored questions such as 'Can we share 7 fairly' and 'how many more do we need to make the groups equal'. This week we learnt about doubles and have been investigating what happens when we double numbers. We found out that when we double something it makes 'the same again'. We had fun exploring this with mirrors and a magic doubling bag!

In Drawing Club, our writing lesson, we used the old cartoon 'Wacky Races' to inspire us! This stemmed from an interest in cars and the road safety day. It really inspired the children and they loved inventing their own cars, making cars and playing races. We have been focusing on writing a sentence with a finger space between each word and making sure we write all the sounds we can hear in words. The children loved writing about their wacky inventions!

In phonics and reading we are learning how to blend consonant letters when we read words such as swim, nest, crunch, pink.

In RE we continue to think about Pentecost and the birth of the Church. Last week we shared our good news, just as the disciples shared the good news of Jesus. This week we will find out why Sunday is such a special day for visiting the Church.
